Submission Deadline: Friday, January 8, 2016

Papers submitted to DJIM must:

- Be about 10 - 20 pages in length. We publish journal articles; please use your judgement.
- Have a clear, contentious claim/thesis, supported by strong, true and related premises, but nuanced and balanced with counter arguments.
- CITE all sources in APA format, even yourself. Be sure to double-check the originality of ideas and give credit to idea development where it is due.
